PRESBYTERY PASTORAL SUPPORT MINISTER: Neil Lackey

It's not news that changes are going on all across our presbytery. The following three areas are the focus of the majority of PSM work.

Congregation Experiences: Forms of ministry (circuit riding) that haven't been seen for years are generating hope in two pastoral charges (4 congregations) as they cooperate with three other congregations and two full time ministry personnel.

Amalgamation discussions here with three congregations, and a few kilometers from here involving 4 congregations include looking at the kind of building / physical plant that will best suit the mission work the amalgamated charge is called to do. One United Church congregation has been heartened that Christian Congregations are sending representatives to a common meeting time to discuss what the future of the Christian Church might look like in a township. Some of our congregations have been disheartened as their letters to others receive little or no response, and feel like churches near by are waiting to reap a harvest of membership and proceeds of property sales rather than working together right now. Even congregations that currently expect a few years of financial stability are realizing they also have to do things differently.

Ministry Experiences: Those called to ministry and covenanted with pastoral Charges in North Huron, and those Covenanted in North West Perth are exploring the calling of God on the form and co-operative nature that will shape future ministry and mission of the Untied Church in their areas. They know things must change. They know the turmoil this generates for congregations and leadership - yet they head hopefully into potentials for co-operation and sharing.

Experiences of Faith: All of these events involve animated discussions, hope and fear. Many involve painful recognitions that long held traditions need to change and give way to different practices. Ministry Leaders remark, "We were never prepared for this". Congregational members wonder "Who is stealing my church?" Rebirthing discussions have heard over and over again that all of us are finding our way together in a time like no other. "We've never done it this way before". But in some ways our discussions and discoveries and changes are fundamental for the people of God who risk journeying, changing, following the way of Jesus based on how God's call for this time and place is understood. This is also a time of increased faithfulness and hope. New ways of living faith that is meaningful to those in and outside the church. Yes, this is a disruptive time of change - and also an invigorating, life-giving time of change to faithfully live Christ's Way.
