- Recognition of 35 Years of Journey & Promise

It all began with a cupboard. After moving resources around in the trunk of a car, a permanent cupboard was located at Main St. United Church in Mitchell. It was moved to the Clinton United Church because of hours of operation and accessibility. A committee was set up by the Huron-Perth Presbytery to study the possibility of setting up a Resource Centre that would be better able to serve the region. They outlined the important qualities of the future Resource Centre:

1. A store-front location
2. Open 5 days a week
3. One paid Manager and many volunteers.

It would offer for sale Bibles and other religious books, Sunday School materials and supplies and UCW study kits. It would also lend out film strips, tapes, records and equipment as necessary. The store front locations would also have a room for previewing film strips or looking through materials.

A suitable facility was located in Mitchell, at the present day Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce. In 1976 the Christian Resource Centre was officially opened by the Dr. Wilbur Howard, current Moderator of The United Church of Canada. The Board of Directors overseeing the Centre consisted of Bob Southcott, Sue Bonsteel, Clara Galway, and Rev. Wilena Brown. Tom Mantle was the first Director, assisted by his wife, Hilda.

In 1977, the Bank of Commerce wanted to expand so the Centre was relocated to its current location, 29 Ontario Road. In 1980 Jean Sykes took over the position as Director from Tom Mantle. At the 25th Anniversary the Moderator, Marion Best, visited. Kathy Butson became the Director in 2003 and Susan Campbell became the Director in 2009.

On October 19, 2011 the current Moderator, Mardi Tindal, visited the Christian Resource Centre to help celebrate its 35th Anniversary. She presented the Centre with a certificate on behalf of the United Church of Canada acknowledging the accomplishment. The Christian Resource Centre for the Huron-Perth Presbytery is the oldest Resource Centre within the United Church of Canada.

Vote: 49 yes, 5 no, 2 abstention Carried.

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5b – The Question: Does the Presbytery agree that, when the appointment of a Designated Lay Minister is at an end, the Presbytery may discern together with the Designated Lay Minister the question of ongoing Presbytery membership; and that the Basis of Union shall be amended to reflect this policy.

Vote: 57 yes, 1 no, 0 abstention Carried.

Eleanor Scarlett welcomed everyone to Main Street United and lit the Christ Candle. A workshop was held with everyone going to small group to discuss "Where are you on the wave" as churches learn to adapt to the wave of change and need to find new ways of doing things.
